Ann K. Frey, 75, died peacefully at home on Wednesday, February 21, 2018, surrounded by her family. Born and raised in Lakewood, Ohio, she was preceded in death by her parents Elizabeth and William Kirkpatrick.

Ann attended Ohio University, where she pursued secretarial studies and met her husband, Larry, who was her TA for an Office Procedures Lab. As a graduation gift from her parents, she traveled to Europe. Love of travel continued throughout her life as she and Larry became “globe trekkers.” She was particularly fond of their yearly visit to Arizona where she realized her dream to see the saguaro in bloom.

Ann liked to do traditional jigsaw and crossword puzzles, but also embraced technology by playing games on her iPad. She enjoyed detective fiction series and card games with her grandson, Joshua.
