Helen Elizabeth "Beth" Prever went home to be with the Lord on August 11, 2017 after a short and powerful battle with ALS. Beth was born in Portsmouth, Virginia. She graduated from Churchland High School and earned a BS Degree in Accounting from University of South Florida. Beth was Senior Vice President of Marketing and Community Relations with TowneBank.

She is survived by her beloved and loving son, Landon Dale Prever (fiancée Sarah Sabellico), her parents Richard A. and Helen Williams, brother Richard (Trey) Williams (Debbie) and her beloved dogs, Hope and Remington. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

Beth was the consummate community servant in both her personal and professional life. Ironically before her illness, she helped to raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for ALS research, Grommet Island Park & Playground for everyBODY, and JT's Camp Grom. She was also active in building houses for Habitat of Humanity, Salvation Army Christmas Depot, Roc Solid Builds, United Way Day of Caring and many other community outreach projects. She previously served as Committee Chair for BSA Troop 207, a member of the Board of Directors of Portsmouth Volunteers for the Homeless and a member of the Board of Directors of Tidewater Council Boys Scouts of America, chairing the Marketing Committee.
