Brenda Louise was born to Brenda and Edward Eugene Joseph in Portsmouth, Virginia. She was an honors graduate of Cradock High School, class of 1989. She received her master's degree in education from Old Dominion University. After she received her master's degree, she served for 25 years at Cradock Middle School, primarily teaching mathematics. Brenda Louise was the 2021 Portsmouth Public Schools Middle School Teacher of the Year. She was a member of Calvary Baptist Church, serving as a teacher in Sunday school, AWANA, and Vacation Bible School. She was also a member of Beverly Wyatt's "My Girl" Sunday school class at Jackson Memorial Baptist Church.
