Because of his faith in Christ, Rev. Damon E. Wyatt, 94, was ushered into the presence of God on Feb. 16th. He is survived by his wife of 72 years, Vivian Saunders Wyatt; a daughter, Dayna Austin, and her husband, P. Jack Austin all of Portsmouth. He left behind two beloved grandsons, Dr. Trae Shepherd and his wife, Emily, of Charlotte, NC, Damon W. Shepherd and his wife, Mary, of Winston-Salem, NC. In addition, he left six great grandchildren, Ella Kaitlin, Lorien Vivian, Ian Scott, Lucy Wyatt, Molly Scott, and Heidi Marie Shepherd.

Rev. Wyatt served in the US Navy and was the former pastor of West Norfolk Baptist. He was the founding pastor of Sweethaven Baptist Church and founder of Sweethaven Christian School.

A private burial will be held at Churchland Baptist Church Cemetery, followed by a public celebration of his life at Calvary Baptist Church on London Blvd. at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, Feb. 19, Rev. 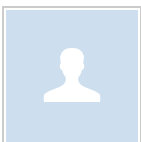
