Donald Rudolph Kostka, 70, passed away on Monday, November 7, 2016 in Chesapeake, VA. Donn was an artist who studied under nationally known painter Barclay Sheaks while attending Warwick High School in Newport News. Upon graduating, Donn moved to California and studied at Chouinard Art Institute (now California Institute of the Arts). Over the years he worked for advertising agencies in California, Arizona and Virginia, all the while painting and illustrating at his drafting table. Art was his life and his passion.
