



## Dr. Kasedul Hoq

August 1, 1928 - June 30, 2006

Dr. Kasedul Hoq's soul slipped gently into the care of the Almighty on Friday, June 30th at 6:20 p.m. He was born in Comilla, Bangladesh but practiced family medicine in Portsmouth and Chesapeake for 40 years. He was active in the medical community, serving in various positions in the Portsmouth Academy of Medicine and Medical Society of Virginia. Dr. Hoq is survived by his wife, Mrs. Tahmina Hoq, his son Masood Hoq, his daughter Dr. Sylvia Hoq Riedler and her husband Dr. John Riedler, as well as his beloved grandchildren Aliah Hoq and Amirul Hoq Sufyani.
