Frances Peddy Moore, 88, was born in Portsmouth VA and departed this world on April 3, 2025.

She graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School in 1954. After graduation, Frances did secretarial work for several years, married her high school sweetheart Judson and stopped work to keep house and raise two children. She was an active adult in the Girl Scouts and Job's Daughters. She was a member of the Pilot Club of Portsmouth and a board of Director's member of the Portsmouth Historical Association. As the children grew older, Frances was offered a job with Bolding & Co (a stock brokerage firm). Being a conscientious and dedicated employee, her employer encouraged her to take the examination licensing by the National Association of Securities Dealers. As one of the few who passed the exam, she became one of the first women in the area to become a licensed stockbroker. She retired after 20 years of service. After retirement, she worked briefly doing secretarial work, then stopped to help raise her grandson.

Frances was a devoted wife, mother, and grandmother and will be greatly missed. She is survived by her husband of 69 years, Judson. Also surviving are their two children; daughter Claudette M Lane of Norfolk VA, son J. Gregory Moore and wife Jamie of Georgia, and two grandsons, Austin Lane and Jordan Moore.
