For Joseph Craig Merrell, life was all about family. That's because he believed that every man, woman, and child walking this beautiful earth is a son or daughter of God. So when he met you, he believed, firmly, deeply, in his giant heart, that you were his brother or sister. You were family; and Craig loved his family.

In 1950, he arrived as the second son of John Yeates and Marjorie Merrell. With his three siblings, John Jr., Karen, and David, Craig thrived in their happy home in Arlington, Virginia. As a young man, two major decisions changed the course of his life. First, while recovering from back surgery, he decided to become a doctor. Second, he answered the call to share the gospel of Jesus Christ in the French-Swiss Mission of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He served a mission as a young man in the Swiss Geneva Mission, and later as mission president for the France Toulouse Mission. On his mission, Craig developed a passion for working with God to heal broken hearts and wounded souls.

While studying medicine at the University of Virginia, Craig was set up on a blind date with Teresa Ann Johnson. They were married on March 6, 1976 and together they raised eight children – Thomas, Michael, David, Stephen, Jonathan, Joshua, Anna, and Sara. Love, music, and faith filled their home. His six daughters-in-law – Wendi, Allison, Rachel, Emily, Cyndia, and Anne –

and 19 grandchildren

Through his work as a plastic and reconstructive surgeon, he was a beloved member of the Tidewater community. He considered his patients as part of his extended family and helping them brought him immeasurable joy. Through his work with Operation Smile, his healing touch extended around the world. He was beloved by his family, friends, colleagues, patients, and community.

Craig was a faithful follower of Jesus Christ and influenced the lives of thousands through his ministry whether he was teaching two-year-olds or leading congregations. He was looking forward to retiring this coming year and taking up a full-time grandfathering position on a quiet farm in the mountains.

“ Trying to wrap my head around this.... J Craig Merrell MD passed way yesterday from an automobile accident on I-664 Suffolk, VA. When I left John Hopkins' Care In 2007, I chose this Plastic Surgeon to help me monitor my skin. His Father had a history of Melanoma, and he used advanced technology in mapping skin lesions. I saw him every 3 months for a couple of years and graduated to 6 month surveillance. He's removed basal & squamous cell lesions from me. In 2014 I decided I needed to give back to the Melanoma community, Merrell jumped right on board, rearranging a family vacation, bringing his staff & family to work 3 years in a row at AIM At Melanoma 5K Run/Walk in, Oak Grove Park, Chesapeake, VA. I provided an air conditioned camper for him to do head to toe skin exams. Each year he found not only Basal & Squamous Cell Cancer but Melanoma. Combining our efforts we raised upwards of \$40,000.00.

Dr Merrell is the father of 8. In 1984 he joined on board with Bill & Kathy Magee in OPERATION SMILE, traveling the world performing and teaching how to repair cleft lips & palate and other craniotomy-facial malformations. He has been awarded Honorary Ambassador OPERATION SMILE. He was a very humble guy....God gave him a gift to use for good & that he did.

I last saw him in late May. He was selling his practice, retiring and moving his family to their West VA farm. My heart aches knowing he won't get to do this, he won't see his huge family of kids and Grands grow and achieve.
