James Willard Calloway, 91, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, January 25, 2014. He was a native of Portsmouth. Willard served in the Navy during WWII aboard the Wolverine as an Aviation Metal Smith and became a member of the American Legion Post #37. He continued with his career at the Norfolk Naval Air Station and retired after 36 years of service. Not one to be idle he then retired from Portsmouth General Hospital as a security person after 15 years.

Willard was a devoted member and deacon of the Portsmouth Christian Church. He was a member of Seaboard Masonic Lodge # 56. He became a 32nd degree Mason in 1973 and Master of Seaboard Lodge in 1980. He was a member of the Portsmouth Scottish Rite Bodies and a member of Kehedive Shrine Temple.

He was predeceased by his sister, Gwen Barrick his wife, Christine, and his previous wife, Edith. He will be greatly missed and never forgotten by his family. He is survived by his daughter, Dolores Robinson and husband Ricky; grandson, Christopher Robinson, and wife Dolores.
