James Todd McRae of Dock Landing Road was born October 23, 1971 and died September 28, 2005 in a local hospital.

Todd was an active member of Churchland Baptist Church where he served as a deacon, was a member of the Foundations Sunday School class, often ushered, and was on many committees. He received his Bachelor of Science degree from East Carolina University, Greenville, NC in 1994 with several honors. Following graduation, he became affiliated with Ferguson Enterprises, Inc. At the time of his death, he was Business Manager of the new HVAC Division.

He is survived by his wife, Melanie Smith McRae and two sons, James Rosser and David Patrick; his mother, Marsha Parker McRae; his father and step-mother, James Armistead and Greta McRae; his brother, Joseph Scott McRae; five step brothers and sisters; the in-law family of David and Trudy Smith; as well as a host of aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Todd was an avid sports fan and loved to play golf with his father, brother, and friends from both work and childhood. However, his happiest times were spent with his wife and "best buddies", Ross and Patrick. He will be remembered as an unselfish, easy-going, patient and caring man. A funeral service will be conducted at Churchland Baptist Church on Saturday,

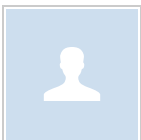
