



## James Donald Varela

August 25, 1942 - May 4, 2007

Rev. James Donald Varela, 64, beloved husband, son, father and grandfather went to be with the Lord on Friday May 3, 2007. Don was a native of Santa Fe, NM, and a member of New Life Providence Church. After graduating from York High School in 1960 Don served 4 years in the Air Force before beginning the first of many business enterprises. Don opened Republic Personnel Service in Norfolk, and it quickly grew to a nationally-franchised company. In the mid-1970s Don accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and served Him by becoming involved in the Catholic Charismatic Community in Tidewater. His ministry efforts included the publication of The Good News Letter, which had an international distribution in the tens of thousands. His shepherd's heart became evident as God called him to be the founding pastor of New Creation Community in Chesapeake. While serving in the ministry, Don was passionate about the cause of the unborn child and uniting fellow pastors in the Tidewater area. His tireless efforts earned him the respect, love and appreciation of the entire Christian community. He was predeceased by his father, Tom Varela. Don was "Papa" to his grandchildren, all of whom he loved and adored. His compassionate heart was shared lovingly with the community through many outreach programs. He gave his time endlessly to those who were suffering or in need.

Don is survived by his wife of 33 years, Joyce Varela; mother, Carmen Varela, 5 children, Gregory Varela, Charmaine Turbitt, Suzanne Hastings, Paul Varela, Samuel Varela; 12 grandchildren; 5 siblings, Kathy Amsler, Thomas

Varela, Anita Lopez, Robert Varela, Geno Varela.

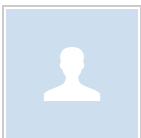

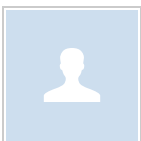
