On the evening of December 20, 2022, our hearts were saddened by the loss of our beloved princess Jordyn Aniyah Smith.

Jordyn was born on August 6, 2010, to Lynette Smith. She was born at 25 weeks gestation at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital, Norfolk Virginia. At 6 weeks of age Jordyn was diagnosed with Short Bowel Syndrome and Chronic Lung Disease. On October 27, 2010, her family was called to Christen her due to complications to surgery. The doctors were certain it was her time to leave this world, but God had other plans for her. At the age of 4, on November 21, 2014, Jordyn became a recipient of a multi organ transplant, receiving large and small intestines, pancreas and liver. Jordyn spent most of her life in and out of the hospital for multiple complications, but her courageous smile never wavered.

Jordyn was a student at Victory Elementary from kindergarten to 6th grade, where her teachers and students adored her. Jordyn loved unicorns, watching cooking shows, and all things pink and purple.

She was truly our “Miracle Princess”.
