She was a representative for Winners on Wheels, a humanitarian cycling group which notably cycled through Belgium to repair special needs equipment for local families. She supported the Deep Creek music program for decades, by sewing and altering band uniforms and choral concert attire and making banners. For many years, she designed and created costumes for a local

dance studio. In addition, she volunteered for fundraising activities for many youth groups, including chorus, softball, and baseball. She was a board member for Deep Creek Baseball Association.

Lois taught kindergarten at the Little Red Schoolhouse for many years, substituted in Chesapeake schools afterward, and then changed her profession to work at a rehab health care equipment supplier. After retiring, she enjoyed spending her time with her family and doing a multitude of crafts.
