Marjorie Rita Cupit, 84, went to be with the Lord on Sunday March 31, 2013. For 50 years, she was a member of Centenary United Methodist Church and frequently played piano and organ for the church. She was a past-President of the Merrifields Garden Club in Portsmouth and Chaired the recycling efforts for the Portsmouth Area Council of Garden Clubs. Mrs. Cupit was an active member of the Fort Nelson Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution after being admitted in 1988. She briefly served as Vice-Regent of the Chapter.

A native of Union Church, Mississippi, Mrs. Cupit is survived by her husband of 66 years, Calvin J. Cupit, a Navy veteran; her sons, Gary C. Cupit and his wife, Bernadette, of New Jersey, W. Don Cupit and his wife, Sherian, of North Carolina; sister Juanita Robinson and four grandsons; Joshua, Daniel in heaven Kyle and Aubrey Cupit. She was predeceased in death by an older brother, Rudolph Wilson.
