Mark C. Caffee, 42, passed away suddenly on Saturday, June 11, 2011. He was a life-long resident of Chesapeake and a member of Aldersgate United Methodist Church. Mark was a 1987 graduate of Western Branch High School, and a graduate of Virginia Wesleyan College. He was employed by Grainger Industrial Supply as a government sales representative for over 20 years. Mark was very active in his children's lives and coached many of their sport teams. Through coaching, he touched the lives of many other children. He was an active member of Western Branch Athletic Club, where he coached and also served as the commissioner of Baseball for several years.

Mark was predeceased by his father, Gerald H. Caffee.
