Maurice "Footie" Fulton Cotton, 82, passed away on Wednesday, October 26, 2005. He was a native of Portsmouth, the Co-owner and Vice President of Cotton Brothers Inc. "Footie" was a member of the 511th Parachute Infantry of the 11th Division of the Army. He was a WWII Veteran and recipient of the Bronze Star and Purple Heart.
