For 11th grade, we got to make our own schedules, so I chose Mrs. Whitehead. She was a wonderful teacher, and I remember I learned a lot from her. When I later became a science teacher, she was definitely an influence in that choice, as well as my teaching style. I always respected her, but after becoming a teacher, too, my awe at her knowledge and ability to share that knowledge sure did increase!!

One of my favorite memories of high school academics was making the peanut brittle in her science lab. I still have and use the recipe for it although, I have kept and used the translated version I had to make to know what to do!!!

I also remember NOT getting into trouble in her class for talking during class to my friend. The girl wasn't the sharpest tool in the shed, so I'd frequently have to fill in the blanks in her notes or re-explain things the teacher had already gone over 20 times. I knew it at the time: Mrs. Whitehead understood what I was doing and was too respectful of the girl's feelings to tell me to be quiet and make the girl go to her for instruction. I always thought that was an honorable thing to do.

Now that my oldest son is in WBHS, I've found several of my "old" teachers still teach there. I was disappointed he'd never have Mrs. Whitehead for a teacher.

I just wanted you to know how your family member touched other lives and affected me.

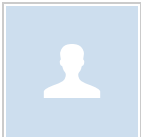
