Paul Harry Chasey, 72, passed away peacefully November 12, 2011.

Paul was born on January 27, 1939 in Long Branch, NJ. Paul was a lifelong educator and began his teaching career in Washington D.C in 1960. He later became an Educational Media Specialist in Prince George's County, MD and then served as a Title I Program Media Specialist for the Portsmouth Public School System.
