



## Paul L. Stafford

February 7, 1926 - July 4, 2007

Paul L. Stafford 81, passed away July 4, 2007 at Sentara Obici Hospital. Paul was born February 7, 1926 in Hazel Green, Alabama. He served in the Navy during World War II in the South Pacific where he was captured by the Japanese and held as a POW until escaping into the jungle. He was later recalled into service in the Korean War. After leaving the service Paul went to work with Ford at the Norfolk Assembly Plant, working in several departments, and retired after 35 years as an inspector. Paul served as Co-Chairman of Local 919 Retirees Group and attended Jolliff United Methodist Church . He was preceded in death by his son, Rick P. Stafford. Paul is survived by his loving wife of 60 years, Ruth H. Stafford; daughter, Janet Stafford Haywood and husband, David; grandchildren, Michelle Stafford Marshall and husband, Robert, Rachel Haywood Batts and husband Robert, and Jeff Haywood and wife, Kelly; great-granddaughters, Jessica Marshall, Haley Giovannelli, Madeline Batts, Austyn Haywood; great-grandsons, Bobby Marshall and Jackson Batts.
