Richard Berry Barrick, 86, passed away on June 16, 2008. A native of Portsmouth, Virginia, born to the late Essie Berry Barrick and Richard Cox Barrick. He attended VA Tech and graduated from MCV College of Dentistry. After teaching at the college, he moved to Portsmouth where he practiced for 45 years. Upon retiring he opened his own company, Barrick Tri City Real Estate. He was a member of the Virginia State Dental Association and past Pres. of the Association. He was a member of the International College of Dentists and The Tidewater Dental Association. He was instrumental in founding the school of dental hygienists at ODU. He belonged to Delta Sigma Delta Fraternity, Supreme Chapter. He was a member of VA Real Estate Board, a member of C.R.E.A., and a member of the national registry of Who's Who. He also served in the U.S Navy as a 1st Lt. during WWII.
