Robert M. Jones Jr., 79, passed peacefully in his home to be with the Lord on Wednesday April, 3rd, 2024. He was a native of Portsmouth, Virginia growing up in the Parkview area of the city. A very proud man who always thought of his family first. Known as a wonderful husband, father and grandfather as well as a cherished friend to many.

He was an honorable Naval Veteran aboard the USS Randolph (CVS-15) from 1962-1966. Upon his return from the Navy, he joined the Portsmouth Police Dept. where he retired after 20 years of service. His last career he served as the Security Coordinator/Investigator at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital retiring from there after 25 years.

He was a lifetime member of Fraternal Order of Police Gosport Lodge #20. Also a member of the Masonic Lodge Portsmouth #100.

He is predeceased by his father, Robert M. Jones, Sr. and mother, Virginia Lipscomb Stotler. He is survived by his loving wife of 60 years, Peggy Jones; three children, Robert B. Jones, Eric H.
