



Robert Marshall Snowden

January 9, 1919 - June 11, 2005

Robert Marshall Snowden, 86, went to be with the Lord on Saturday June 11, 2005. He was a native of Norfolk, member of Aldersgate United Methodist Church and an Army Veteran of WWII. Robert was awarded the Air medal for service during the Battle of the Bulge.

Mr. Snowden is survived by his wife of 67 years, Nellie C. Snowden; three children, Ruth Snowden Emmons, Robert J. Snowden and Katherine S. Rivenbark; eight grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; a sister, Helen Ann Presley and two brothers, Roth Snowden and Jimmy Snowden. He was predeceased by his parents Virginia and Thomas Snowden and a brother Thomas Snowden.

A funeral service will be held at 3:00 p.m. Tuesday in Loving Funeral Home, Churchland Chapel by Rev. Larry Adams, with burial in Horton Veteran Cemetery in Suffolk at a later date.
