Roy V. Jones, 97, died peacefully at Lake Prince Woods in Suffolk, VA on Monday Jan. 4, 2016. Originally from Scottsville, VA, he was the oldest of ten children born to Kelley and Nellie (Frye) Jones. A graduate of Gary High School in Gary, WV, he moved to Portsmouth in 1941 and began working at Norfolk Naval Shipyard.
