Scott Harris, Jr, 90, died July 15, 2017 in Suffolk. Mr. Harris was born in Rocky Mount, NC to the late Ruby and C. Scott Harris, Sr. He graduated from Suffolk High school. He was a naval veteran of WWII. He married Alma Joyce Bridges, his high school sweetheart on Sept. 21, 1946.
