Morris Steven Fink, 71, was called home by his Lord and Savior on July 7, 2023, at his home surrounded by family. He was born and raised in Portsmouth, VA by the late Dorothy Perryman Fink and Morris Fink. A 1971 graduate of Churchland High School and a 1974 graduate of Bluefield College in West Virginia.

Steve is survived by his loving wife of almost 21 years, Linda Fink; his children, Matthew Fink, Jessica Fink Fly and her husband T.J., Cathy Lancaster and husband Taz; 5 grandchildren, Colton Fly, Sadie Fly, Austin Higginbotham, Easton Lancaster, and Tre Fly. Steve is also survived by his siblings, Mike Fink and his wife Marsha, his sister Candy Fink Fawcett and husband Roger, along with numerous nieces and nephews.

Steve was a man of faith who loved and served the Lord which was reflected in all aspects of his life. He was a former member of Jackson Memorial Baptist Church, Community Church, and a current member of Restore Church. Steve was a Men's Bible Group of Town Point Club member. He was a hard worker and a true entrepreneur. He founded and opened Fink's Wheel Shop in 1979, and a few years later, he decided to add an additional business venture and opened up Yogurt Delight at Portside. Steve later opened two additional locations in Churchland and Stonebridge. After some time, he sold both businesses and then decided to start Fink's Truck Frame and Alignment in the

early 1990s. This is where he worked with his children up until his retirement. After his retirement, he worked at Loving Funeral Home. Steve was always up for an adventure and ready to try something new. He was a peacemaker, a natural leader, an incredible father and loving husband that led by example. He had a big giving heart, was always ready to lend a hand and was a friend to all.

In his last years, his quality of life was limited due to his battle with Parkinson's. His family would like to express their gratitude to all of his loving caregivers, Farmers Home Health Care, and especially Mechelle, Pam, and Kia.
