You enjoyed looking through photos as much as I enjoyed taking them and sharing them with you. One of my favorite memories was when I took you to the airport so you could go to the Philippines. Hurricane Isabell was on the way and you insisted that I take this huge pan of lumpia that you had just made in case the power went out so they wouldn't go bad. Well, the power did go out but because we had a gas stove, we were able to cook them all and the whole neighborhood feasted on your culinary goodness.

As your journey on this earth came to an end, you left all of us with one final life lesson and memory....it didn't matter what kind of gifts

were under the tree this year because the greatest gift is life itself and how we choose to live it with those closest to us. 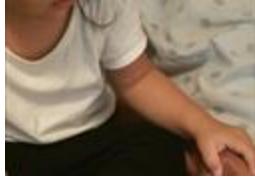

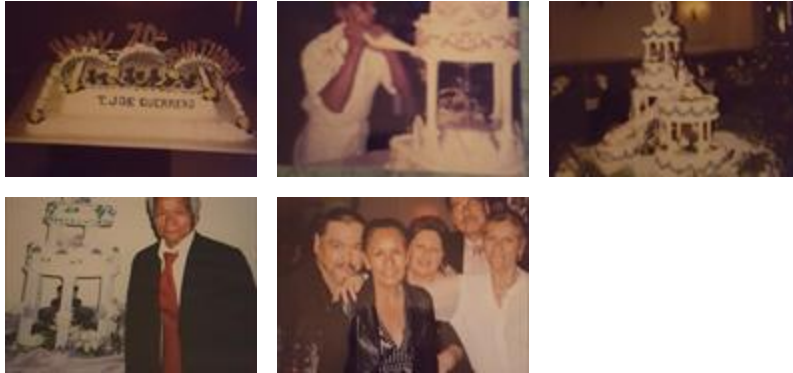
