Vern D. King 86 died on April 23, 2011. He was born in Princeton, Illinois. Mr. King served honorably in the U.S. Naval Construction Battalion Seabees during WWII. He was employed by the New York Naval Shipyard in Brooklyn from 1951 to 1965, then transferred to the Norfolk Naval Shipyard in Portsmouth, from which he retired in 1980.

He was predeceased by his wife of 60 years, Mildred King, on January 30, 2005 and his daughter, Carol Lynn Mayer-Cowden, on October 14, 2006. Mr. King is

survived by his son, Richard V. King, of Dallas, Texas; daughter, Linda E. King, of Norfolk, Virginia; grandchildren Thomas Mayer of Seattle, Washington, Stephen Cowden of Gilbert, Arizona, and Kathryn Mayer of Richmond, Virginia; and 5 great grandchildren.
