William Wyatt Trask, born on Aug 24, 1928 to William and Gertrude Chandler. He took the Trask name upon the marriage of his mother to Philip H. Trask. A graduate of George Washington University, he went on to become a reporter for the Virginia Pilot and subsequently a Assistant City Editor for the Daily Commercial News in Tallahassee FL.
